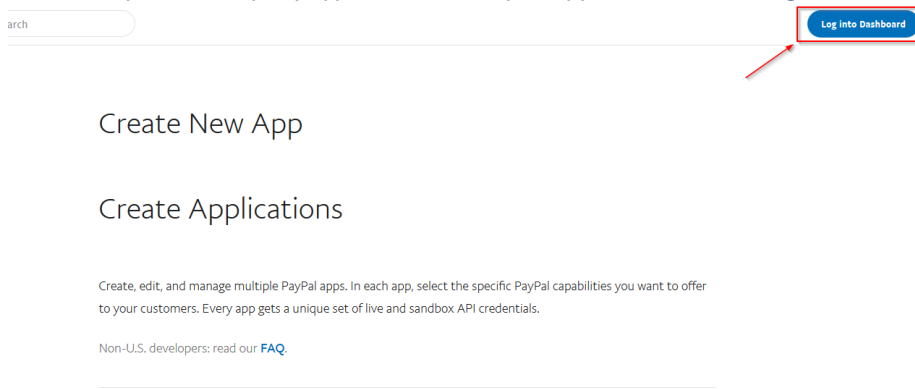
When it comes to ease of use and security, PayPal is a favorite among both businesses and consumers. On your SimplePart site, you have the ability to integrate either PayPal Standard, Pro, or Express as valid payment options.

Tip: We recommend having a combination of PayPal and a Payment Gateway (Credit Card) options to increase the payment opportunities for your online customers.

PayPal Express is a quicker and easier way for your customers to pay for their orders on your online store. And it's relatively easy to sign up.

1. Go to <https://developer.paypal.com/developer/applications/> click Log into Dashboard in top right corner.



2. Log in to PayPal account using email and password.
